Ten \$1,000 Scholarships

Scholarship Criteria

- Applicants must be planning to attend one of the ten interior post-secondary institutions in the fall of 2016 (see list of 'Post-Secondary Institutions' on the left). Entering a program during 2nd semester of 2017 is acceptable as well.
- Preference will be given to students <u>entering a forestry-related program</u> (see list of 'Fields of Study' on right). Students entering other areas of study may apply, knowing there is a preference for forestry related study.
- Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded on receipt by COFI of documentation confirming registration and proof of payment (copy of tuition receipt) at an approved post—secondary institution.
- Scholarships have to be used for the 2016-7 academic year, <u>deferral of up to</u> <u>one school year is possible for special circumstances.</u>
- Incomplete applications will not be considered for the scholarship.
- The decision of the scholarship committee is final.
