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UNBC SCIENCE FIELD TRIP

EBUS has partnered with UNBC to offer a three-day science field trip on **MAY 22-24th, 2019**. This field trip is open to all EBUS students or School District 91 students in grades 10-12. Students will participate in three jam-packed days of learning and hands-on science labs in university laboratories! Students will also have the opportunity to learn more about research at UNBC and student life on campus.

Field Trip Activities:

- Hands-on Chemistry and Biology labs
- Tour of the NALS lab
- Nature hike through Forest of the World
- Campus tour and opportunities to learn from current students and science faculty
- Opportunity to attend a first-year lecture
- Cinema night
- Fun, team-building activities, and more!

ITINERARY

The trip will start on **Wed, May 22nd at 9:00 am on campus at UNBC**. Parents will drop-off students at meeting spot with teacher chaperones. The trip ends on **Friday May 24th at 12:00 noon** and parents will pick up students on campus. A full itinerary will be sent to all participating students in May.

TRAVEL & ACCOMMODATIONS

Students will stay on campus in UNBC residence in Prince George, BC for the duration of the trip and will be chaperoned by EBUS teachers. Students will stay in groups of four in UNBC full service 4-bedrooms suites that include wifi, bedding, towels, kitchenware and small appliances. Meals will be provided as part of the field trip.

There is no cost to stay on residence at UNBC. There may be a minimal fee for non-EBUS students to help cover the costs of food. We are working to minimize this fee as much as possible.

All students who can travel to Prince George to attend the trip are welcome to attend. Parents are responsible for transporting students to and from UNBC. Students who are travelling far distances, please contact Megan Boniface (mboniface@sd91.bc.ca).
