Leading Paradigm Changing Cancer Clinical Trials from Northern BC

Dr. Olson is a practicing Radiation Oncologist at BC Cancer and Associate Professor at UBC. He is the head of the Division of Radiation Oncology at UBC, and the Associate Head of Research in the Department of Surgery at UBC. In his role at the Northern Medical Program, he is the research lead, and holds an affiliate appointment at UNBC. His research focus includes Patient Reported Outcomes, Health Services Delivery Research (with a focus on rural cancer care delivery), and Clinical Trials. He is the Principal Investigator on multiple national and international clinical trials including paradigm changing trials in the use of stereotactic ablative radiotherapy (SABR) in the setting of limited metastatic disease.
