Course Overview:

The Course:

Second Language 7 requires students to progress through the self-paced online learning platform Mango Languages, in one of 3 language choices: French, Spanish, or Japanese. If students wish to continue with the language into High School, it is recommended that they take either French or Spanish.

Course Materials:

There is no textbook for this course, as all course material is provided online through Mango Languages. There are many Units available for each language, but we are only going to cover Units 1 and 2. Within each unit there are chapters, and each chapter contains several lessons. Unit 1 has 4 chapters, and Unit 2 has 10 chapters. Check out the check list document provided for each language for details of how many lessons there are within each chapter, as these vary by language being studied.

Testing/Assessment information:

As noted within the moodle course there is no direct link between Mango Languages and our system, so I must rely on you to submit screen shots for material completion and other assessment marks.

Each chapter requires 3 items be submitted: [Lessons completed screen shot](#), [quiz results screen shot](#), and [an oral assignment](#) (usually audio or video files). At the end of the unit is a unit test, of which you will be required to submit a screen shot. As well as, a forum submission, and reply, based on the material covered so far.

There is no cumulative final exam.
